- **Pubpub** our toolkits are possibly across multiple platforms —website stats/analytics and usage—we should think about migrating all of the toolkits to Pubpub
 - New version becoming available in May 2025 but will be more expensive or will we be moving to another platform? Info on this change and will add this item to the agenda for the next meeting

 - This PubPub change will impact everything that's currently hosted on PubPub
 - Priority item-Older toolkits need updating (Damita Snow has asked about the process for this) - could be part of the same process-yes-updating the toolkits
 - Reaching out the those who worked on the toolkits originally and see if they can support the updates– This is the Plan for updating C4DISC resources we agreed in 2023. (Bernie)
 - Create a pubpub poll for those using the toolkits directly on the website
 - Ideas: create a popup poll–who is using them, how are they being used, etc
- Partner and Member Value Proposition Strategic Objective:

Update - Bernie has emailed a proposal that covers enhancing our offering to Partners and enabling us to audit DEIA work happening in member organizations.

 - Idea from Sarah: Use the webinar space to present on toolkits and their use. Multiple presentations already developed.

 - Bernie if the proposal to add a staff member focused on programming goes forward, that person may be able to manage the partner webinar series without having to go through a committee to make it happen
- Should we look at adding another part-time staffer, focused on programming, rather than communication?
 - Melanie S., Bernie, and Vanesa have met to discuss. Bernie and Vanesa to combine thoughts on where resources would be useful before the Nov meeting. There is money in the budget to add an additional position if warranted-Programming Support Staff
 - Thoughts from Steering Committee meeting attendees will be asked upon once Bernie and Vanesa meet.
 - Initial ask- what is the difference between programming support/facilitation support vs Bernie's communication role
 - There's a lot of committee facilitation happening that's falling on Bernie
 - Examples of support-the webinar series and facilitating working groups (along with taking notes for meetings)
